Kent Cricket - Safe Hands Tutor

Kent Cricket is committed to Safeguarding Children, Young People and Adults participating in our sport. We expect all our employees, volunteers and contractors to share this commitment. All Affiliated clubs must have a trained Club Welfare Officer who has attended the ECB Safe Hands course.

Kent Cricket delivers between 3 and 6 Safe Hands courses per year for Club Welfare Officers. These usually take place in the evenings (18:30 – 21:30 hours) across the County and sometimes on Saturday mornings subject to tutor availability. The County Welfare Officer is also in attendance at the courses.

The ECB will provide a 'Train the Trainer' course and tutors must attend this before commencing the role and must also complete the online ECB Safeguarding Young Cricketers Course.

The training event will take place at **Burleigh Court, Loughborough University, LE11 3GR** and will include one night's accommodation, meals and travel expenses.

The proposed dates* are:

- 28th – 29th January 2021 (arrive by 11am on the 28th January)
or
- 30th – 31st January 2021 (arrive by 11am on the 30th January)

**Due to the ongoing Covid-19 situation, it is likely there will be another event scheduled for later in the Spring when measures allow this type of training for all.*

The ECB will be delivering the content of the new Safe Hands course and tutors will then have an opportunity to familiarise themselves with the content before splitting into groups and working on presentations. There will be a process of evaluation and support during the event which is ongoing to ensure consistent delivery across the network. This event is mandatory for all Safe Hands Tutors.

Tutors are paid in the region of £80 to £90 by the ECB, plus travel expenses for each Safe Hands course delivered.
