

# Traffic Light Cricket

- Batting Team in 'clubhouse' a safe distance from batter
- Fielding Team including bowler and wicket keeper
- Bowling marker to indicate bowling position 10m from batter
- Red, orange and green cones laid out at increasing distance from batter as in plan
- Bowler bowls ball, if batter hits or doesn't hit the ball, they have to run
- If the batter runs around the red cone and makes it back to the stumps before the bowler gets the ball back on their marker, they score 1pt
- If the batter runs around the orange cone (as indicated by the example arrow below) and makes it back to the stumps before the bowler gets the ball back on their marker, they score 5pts
- If the batter runs around the green cone and makes it back to the stumps before the bowler gets the ball back on their marker, they score 10pts
- If they do not make it back to the stumps before the bowler gets the ball back on their marker, the batter scores no points
- The next batter in line has a turn and so on through the team until everyone has had one or two goes, then the teams switch
