## **Tutor Role**

- Ensure effective delivery of The ECB Safe Hands Course, working closely with the County Cricket network and ECB Safeguarding Team to achieve a consistent learner experience across the Club Welfare Officer qualification.
- Deliver high quality sessions, presenting content in a positive and consistent learner experience.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

- Demonstrate high expectations of yourself and ensuring a positive learning experience for all learners.
- Maintain correct and timely records of learner attendance and achievement.
- Commit to continual professional development and supporting quality assurance processes
- Supporting individual learner needs and adapting to these as appropriate to ensure courses are inclusive
- Risk assess venue on arrival, set up training room as appropriate and ensure health and safety needs are met
- Maintain mandatory training requirements, ensuring they are in date at all times.
